



# Eugene “Gene” K. Krebs

Eugene “Gene” K. Krebs spent eight years in the Ohio House of Representatives, three years on a local school board, and four years as a county commissioner. Krebs has been a research executive in an organization that studies economic development, urban revitalization, and farmland preservation. He was also an executive in a research group that studies healthcare and human-service issues. He served on Ohio’s Joint Committee on High Technology Start-Up Business, Sales Tax Holiday Study Committee (chair), and the Eminent Domain Task Force.

Krebs was appointed by Governor Ted Strickland to Ohio’s 21st Century Transportation Task Force and by Governor John Kasich to the Local Government Innovation Council. Krebs is a three-time winner of the Watchdog of the Treasury award for supporting fiscally frugal policies and has a concealed-carry license. He also has appeared on a regular basis on the PBS television show *Columbus on the Record* and has been featured on CNN, BBC, *The State of Ohio*, *The Spectrum*, and *All Sides with Ann Fisher* as a Republican voice on many political and policy issues. Further, Krebs has been published in *The Wall Street Journal* on economic policy and several times in *The Columbus Dispatch* and *The Plain Dealer* (Cleveland) on state policy issues and is frequently sought by the media for insights on various issues.

Krebs is married to Jan, an award-winning professional artist who works in many different styles and materials. They have two grown daughters who have blessed them with five grandchildren. His principal hobby is a small flock of mostly Dominique chickens, the breed brought to America by the Pilgrims.
