FINANCIAL: Being able to purchase the goods and services of daily life and sustain it



RELATIONAL: Having individuals and support systems in place to encourage and provide guidance



INTELLECTUAL: Having the mental abilities and acquired skills (reading, writing, computing) to deal with daily life



SPIRITUAL: Believing in (divine) purpose and guidance



EMOTIONAL: Being able to choose and control emotional responses, particularly to negative situations, without engaging in self-destructive behavior. Shows itself through choices.



PHYSICAL: Having physical health and mobility

The Together Community Center is the hub of the community to connect needs and resources. Located in the old Paradise Elementary School, it is where individuals in our community can find a safe and caring environment to share their struggles and find a place where their journeys matter. Business hours are 8:00am-4:00pm Monday-Friday. The Together Community Center is the location of our Social Services (appointments and workshops), Youth Center Open Door Nights, and satellite campus of Community Services Group.

We offer resource workshops like Tabor Financial Classes and Resume Building by Career Link. Whenever you attend a resource workshop or meet with a case worker, you earn Factory Bucks to spend in our Food Pantry.

The Factory Youth Center meets at the Together Community Center Thursdays, 6:00pm-8:00pm for Open Door Nights. These nights provide a safe and nurturing place for teens of Eastern Lancaster County to connect with caring staff and a God who loves them unconditionally. Games, relationships, safe discussions, a lesson, and a nutritious full dinner are provided to students grades 7-12.
