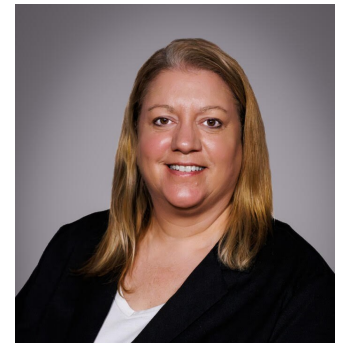


Carrie Arnold

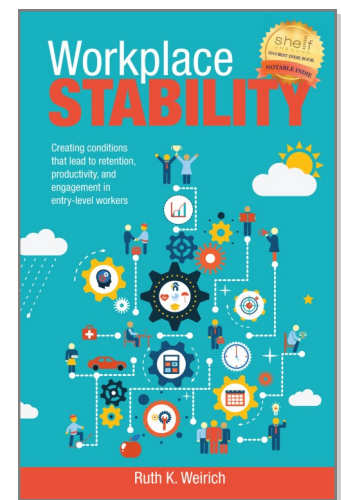

Instead of terminating him, we erased his points and transferred him to another location less than half a mile from his home."
