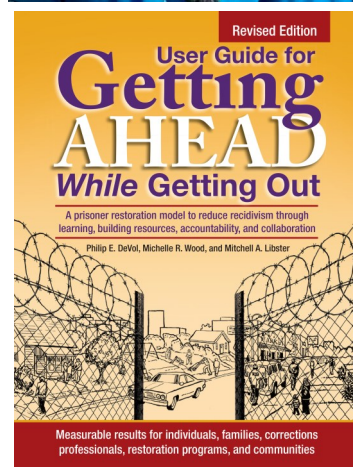
He currently also serves on the executive board of Emerge Solutions, a professional learning network of individuals sharing ideas, best practices and tools to help stabilize individuals and communities.
